### CASA GRANDE DONATES RADIOS TO POLICE



**BALI, July 7, 2003**—The island's police officers will be better tuned in, thanks to a recent donation of 62 two-way radios by Casa Grande Association to Bali's Police Headquarters. Bali Police Chief I Made Mangku Pastika accepted this donation in response to his request for 100 new radios.

The initial radio units will be employed at Ngurah Rai International Airport, where police presence has been doubled from 50 to 100 officers, according to Pastika. The new radios will facilitate speedy response from 16 main patrol points at the airport, he added.

Pastika told the association representatives that his 11,000-strong police force soon will inspect each of Bali's hotel properties, to become familiar with each property and their facilities. Such familiarization will be critical in case of emergencies.
